## Pests and diseases of pistachio trees

Pistacia vera L. is the only species exploited commercially. It is native to east Asia and mediterranean basin. Pistacia is a genus of the Anacardiaceae. There are different speacies of this familly in Iran, included:

- 1) Pistacia mutica (Baneh). 2) Pistacia khinjuk (chatelankosh). 3) Pistacia vera(peste).
- P. Mutica and P.Khinjuk, these are wild trees in Kohkiloyeh, Fars, Kerman, Kordestan, Lorestan and ect.
- *P. Vera* is dioecious. It is planted directly in the garden. When planted from place to another place, dies. There are two way for porpagation: 1) Layering 2)Seed sowing. This is better to use seed because transplanting tends 50-60 percent losses. *P. vera* is usually planted on the sandy, clay, loam soils. If you add chemical and animal fertilizer the yield will be, increased.

The important pests of pistachio are: 1) Pistachio tree hoppers. (Idiocerus stali). 2) Oyster shell scale (Lepidosaphes sp.) 3) Capnodis carbonaria Pol 4) Chactoptelius vestitus. 5) Megastigmus pistacia and important disease are: 1) Collar root 2) Erysiphales.
