## The role of fungal diseases to decrease the orchard production

Fungal diseases are one of the most important factors that limit the orchard production and cause most damage. These diseases are: foliar diseases, such as *Venturia inaqualis*, root rot diseases, such as *Fusarium* and *Verticillium*, *Armillaria* and *Phytophthora*. We have studied that if we regard the correct principles in the orchard such as regulated irrigation, the pests and dideases control and fertilization, the damage of the diseases will become very low.
