Cultivated area of this plant is more than 40000 hectare and Guilan province has the most proportion of it's cultivated area.

In 1991 and 1992 some fungi such as:

Acremonium cf. furcatum, *A. alternata*, *Alternaria sp.*, *Colletotrichum gloesporioides*, *Botrytis cf. cinerea*, *Phyllosticta theae* and etc. were isolated of tea shrub.
